The Dirty South Bat Company, LLC has withdrawn its **Kamo Model BB KA 8** (30/22, 31/21, 32/22, 31/23, 32/24 only - pictures shown below). Dirty South will review the test results and the BPF compliance of this Model to determine if this withdrawal will be permanent. ## Wilson Company / DeMarini

**DeMarini baseball bat Model 2<sup>3</sup>/4" DeMarini 2018 CF Zen CBZ (32/-10 and 31/-10 only)** have been suspended from TBUSA play. Wilson/DeMarini will have the opportunity to prove that this withdrawal should be lifted. If standards are meet for such Model then the bat would be removed from the not eligible for play list.

The illegal bat use by a player will result in the both the head coach and the player who used the illegal bat be **EJECTED** from the game in progress. The illegal bat has to be discovered before the next pitch to a batter of either team. If the bat is deemed illegal by the umpire and/or Tournament Director, the defensive coach has the choice of the batter being called out and all players return to base prior to the at bat or take the play.
